## **2010 ROAD RACING CONTINGENCY PROGRAM**

### **OUTLINE**

The 2010 Suzuki Canada **Regional Road Racing Contingency Program** is available at RACE, CMRA, ARL, WMRC, MRA and EMRA regional events and will also be paying Pro Sportbike and Pro Superbike TFR Championships. Only 2009 & 2010 model year Suzuki GSX-R or SV650S motorcycles purchased in Canada will be eligible. For **AMATEUR** Classes, 2008, 2009, 2010 model year Suzuki GSX-R and SV650S motorcycles purchased in Canada will be eligible.

The 2010 Suzuki Canada **National Road Racing Contingency Program** will be available to riders competing on 2009 or 2010 Canadian model Suzuki GSX-R motorcycles and in AMATEUR Classes on 2008, 2009, 2010 model year Suzuki GSX-R motorcycles purchased in Canada in the Parts Canada Superbike Championship series.

### **REGISTRATION**

To be eligible, riders must be registered with Suzuki Canada Inc. by completing and submitting the "2010 ROAD RACING CONTINGENCY RIDER REGISTRATION FORM" available from your authorized Suzuki dealer or our web site at: [www.suzuki.ca](http://www.suzuki.ca). More information on the Parts Canada Superbike Championship can be found at [www.cdnsuperbike.com](http://www.cdnsuperbike.com). **Suzuki Canada Inc. must receive registrations by July 23, 2010 or prior to any races you are entering to be eligible for contingency from the date they are received. There will be no "retro-active" payments on forms received after July 23, 2010.** It is **your responsibility** to ensure that Suzuki Canada Inc. has received your registration form. Registered mail to Suzuki Canada Inc., 100 East Beaver Creek Rd, Richmond Hill, ON, L4B 1J6 is the best method to ensure delivery.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. In all classes where Suzuki **pays to 3<sup>rd</sup> position there must be a minimum of 8 riders.** Payout is based on the overall result.
2. **◆** Colour scheme Suzuki blue and white (SV's exempt from colour scheme only).
  - ◆ Front fairing must have "Suzuki" no smaller than ¾" x 4" displayed prominently.
  - ◆ Fuel tank must have "S" emblem no smaller than 2" x 2" displayed prominently on right and left side of motorcycle.
  - ◆ Both right and left hand fairings must have "Suzuki" 2" x 12" displayed prominently.
3. All contingency awards will be paid by cheque. The cheques will be issued once the official results have been verified with the sanctioning bodies. Please allow at least 10 weeks for verification of results and issuing of payments.
4. Contingency Award recipients grant Suzuki Canada Inc. the right to use their names, results and photos as deemed necessary in any advertising and promotion, without compensation or prior approval.
5. Suzuki Canada Inc. will only pay contingency in the specified classes as listed in the 2010 Contingency Program and the schedule of qualifying, sanctioned events within the specified time period (May 1, 2010 to October 31, 2010).
6. It is the **rider's responsibility** to resolve any race result disputes with the sanctioning body. **No Payments will be made for races included in the 2010 Suzuki Contingency Program after December 31, 2010. Any errors or missed payments must be reported in writing prior to December 31, 2010 or those payments will be forfeited.**
7. Suzuki Canada Inc. reserves the right to modify or amend this contingency program without notice or obligation.
